



INTRODUCTION:

This office received an agreement letter for the reprogramming of funds from the Community Development Block Grant Program for PY 2022, in the amount of \$1,856,090.00 for the County's Infrastructure program.

RECOMMENDATION AND REASONS:

It is recommended by the Office of the County Engineer that the Essex County Board of Chosen Commissioners adopt a resolution inserting an item of revenue a Grant, in the amount of \$1,856,090.00, in the budget. A copy of the supporting resolution should be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget and four (4) copies to the Office of the County Engineer.

FISCAL IMPACT:

According to State regulations implementing this program, Essex County will administer its projects, be responsible for bidding contracts, supervising construction and paying contractors. Funding this year will provide funds to continue with the improvements of Essex County roads, bridges and traffic intersections throughout the County. Approval of the resolution will permit the Office of Management and Budget to insert an item of revenue a grant in the amount of \$1,856,090.00 in the budget.


